[Headington Baptist Church](#) in Oxford is a lively, loving, God-centred church family. We are looking to take on a new [Centre for Youth Ministry](#) (CYM) student youthworker from this September, potentially for a three-year term.

We are seeking a young person with leadership potential, aged 18+, who would like the opportunity to work under the supervision of the church's *Family and Children's Worker* as a student youthworker, befriending and discipling young people through a variety of youth activities. This is an apprenticeship-type scheme that would, over three years, lead to an accredited BA (Hons) in Young People, Communities and Practical Theology and Youthwork (JNC-endorsed) through CYM. The scheme is an excellent opportunity to earn an accredited degree for just £5,950 per year in fees, whilst gaining work/life experience within a local church placement (14 hours/week). A bursary and gift towards accommodation is provided by the church. Additionally, the role could potentially include a minor placement with a youth project based in a church plant area.
